From the Membership Secretary

By the 15th of November you will receive your dues statement for 2012. Deadline for paying dues is January 31, 2012.

- If you are not married, you will pay \$60.
- If you are married, you will pay \$100.
- If you are an unmarried senior or a junior, you will pay \$45.
- If you are a senior couple, you will pay \$90.

Statements are sent to you in November so that you can pay your dues before Christmas bills come in or so that you can make partial payments of November - \$35, December - \$35, January - \$30, if you are married or November - \$20, December - \$20, January - \$20, if you are single.

You will be dropped from National and Local membership if you do not pay your dues. Should you decide to be reinstated, it will be 90 days from reinstatement before you will be able to participate in District or National functions.

If you are not intending to renew your dues for 2012, please indicate that on the dues statement so you can be dropped in good standing. In good standing means you will not be charged a reinstatement fee. Dues statements and money may be turned in to the bartender or mailed in the envelope enclosed with your statement.

Members who have been Turner members 15 years and who are at least 60 years old will pay the senior rate. It is your responsibility to inform me when you arrive at those two magical numbers since I don't know how old you are.

2011 VORWART AND AWARD INFORMATION

The 2011 Awards Dinner will be held Friday, January 27, 2012. Free dinner will be provided. Below are the nomination forms. The forms are also posted on the website, FortWayneTurners.org. Nominations must be turned in by December 20, 2011. Below are the procedures and rules for nomination.

2011 FORT WAYNE TURNER AWARDS

It is not too early to begin thinking about who you feel deserves a Turner Award. Remember, if you feel strongly that someone you know deserves to be recognized for any of the following awards, **YOU** need to submit the name. Do not rely on someone else doing the recommendation or it may not get done! Don't wait until you forget, **DO IT NOW! DEADLINE FOR ALL AWARDS IS December 20, 2011. TO RETURN NOMINATIONS, PLACE IN ENVELOPE, ATTENTION AWARDS COMMITTEE AND TURN IN AT THE BAR TO BE PLACED IN THE AWARDS MAILBOX.**

REMEMBER: You don't have to be a writer. Simply submit the name of the individual you wish to nominate and list important information to support your nomination. The Awards Committee will write the presentation in the event your nominee is selected.

VORWARDS AWARD: Nominations shall be in writing and shall include information as to why that person should be considered. Person or persons submitting must sign the nomination. The list of nominees shall become the property of the Vorwards Award Committee and shall remain secret. The nominee shall be a member as described in the Fort Wayne Turner Constitution and By-laws under Article 3, Sections A, B, D, E, and F. The nominee shall be considered on the merits of his or her volunteer service to Fort Wayne Turners. The recipient shall be the nominee who, in the opinion of the committee, has contributed the most to the Turner principles of promoting health, physical education, cultural education, happiness and progress of mankind. An appropriate plaque will be presented to the recipient, and the recipient's name will appear on the permanent Vorwards Award Plaque at the Fort Wayne Turners Club. A nominee who is not given the Vorwards Award and who, in the majority of opinion of the committee is very deserving shall be kept for future consideration.

TONY MARKLAND MEMORIAL YOUTH AWARD: Nominations shall be in writing and shall include information as to why that person should be considered. Person or persons submitting must sign the nomination. The Tony Markland Memorial Youth Award is presented to the youth that best exemplifies the qualities Tony possessed and lived by. A person of high moral standards, with firm family and community commitments, possessing a good mental attitude and an active Turner person.

MAN OR WOMAN OF THE YEAR AWARD: Nominations shall be in writing and shall include information as to why that person should be considered. Person or persons submitting must sign the nomination. These awards are presented to the man or woman who, within the past year, volunteered their time to the betterment of Fort Wayne Turners.
