Turners 2012 Softball Scope of Work

All bids are to be turned in to Maintenance Trustee at Fort Wayne Turners, 3636 Parnell Dr., Fort Wayne, IN 46808

Total prep-work for Diamonds for 2012 season – This will include putting down diamond dry, push water off of the field in the morning for afternoon prep work. Chalk and drag the field sometime during the day as weather permits.

- 14 weeks x 5 days a week—70 days
- 12 weekend tournaments days—12 days
- 17 weekends of Sunday league—10 days

Line grass on diamonds weekly.

Trash removal – cans and ground as needed.

Chalk diamond daily.

Total prep-work for sand volleyball court. Drag courts 1 time a week for 13 weeks.

Turners will supply – tractor to drag diamonds, diesel fuel and repairs for our tractor, line paint, line chalk, trash bags and turf dry. Turners will not supply any other material, equipment, or labor.

Note Turners would like break down of pricing for these extra cost:

- Price for setting up diamonds per day.
- Price for setting up diamonds per weekend.
- Hourly rate for any extra work needed.
- Price for volleyball courts per time.
- 7 weeks of one diamond prep once a week.

Contractor will invoice Turners monthly for eight equal payments and any extras “April – November”. No check will be distributed until DETAILED invoice is received by the Maintenance Trustee.

Turners 2012 Lawn Scope of Work

All bids are to be turned in to Maintenance Trustee at Fort Wayne Turners, 3636 Parnell Dr., Fort Wayne, IN 46808

- Mow, trim, edge sidewalks, blow all debris, pick up trash, and including ball diamonds – 26 cuts per season.
- Mow ball diamonds – 6 extra times.
- Fertilize and weed control. “Mulch bed, cracks and lawns.” Three applications – Required to tell the Maintenance Trustee each time application is applied.
- Spray weed killer and poison ivy control on warning track and Johnny Appleseed hill. (3 applications)
- Trimming all of the shrubs and perennials.
- Work for landscape beds during spring clean up or before July 1st.
- Remove excess mulch if needed.
- Edge and re-mulch.
- Spring clean up – Leaf clean up and removal of any annual plants and fallen branches.
- Fall clean up – Removal of any annual plants and fallen branches.
- Blow leaves in fall as needed.
- Weed mulch beds weekly, not including Johnny Appleseed hill.
- Blow parking lot 1 time a week.**

- Price for extra lawn cutting
- Hourly rate for any extra work needed

Contractor will invoice Turners monthly for eight equal payments and any extras “April – November”. No check will be distributed until DETAILED invoice is received by the Maintenance Trustee.
