Thanks to all Germanfest workers and the voting committee workers.

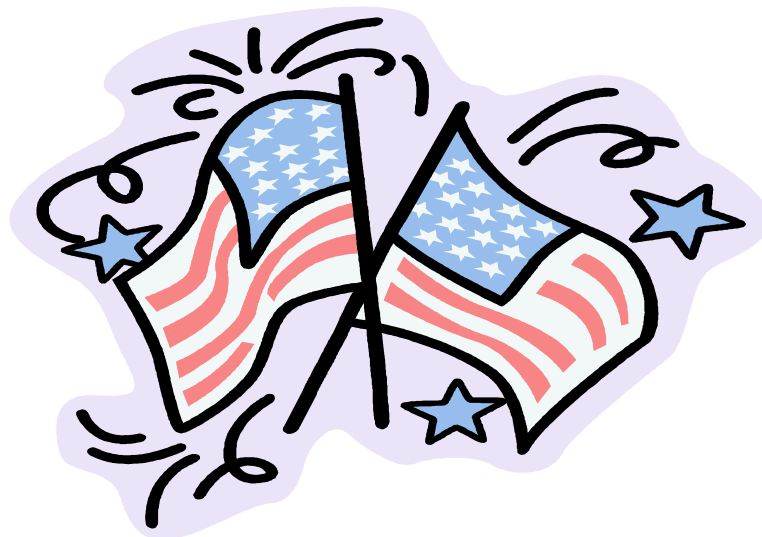
We need help for the Bill Whetstone Memorial Softball Tournament. . . there are sign up sheets at the club.

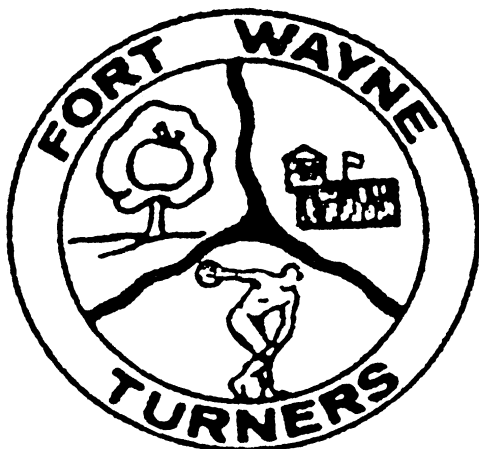
